ASSIGNED READING

Saving Hamlet by Molly Booth

ASSIGNMENT

Your assignment is to read *Saving Hamlet* by the first day of class.

There will be a Socratic Seminar on this book. The Socratic Seminar is a formal discussion, based on a text, in which the leader asks open-ended questions. Within the context of the discussion, students listen closely to the comments of others, thinking critically for themselves, and articulate their own thoughts and their responses to the thoughts of others. You will want to properly prepare for the Socratic seminar by taking notes and/or using post-its to mark important ideas throughout the book. You will not receive points for this, but annotating the book is essential to prepare for a Socratic seminar. More information about the Socratic Seminar process will be provided to you during the first week of class.

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ASSESSMENT

There will be a class discussion and quiz on *Saving Hamlet* during the first two weeks of the new school year.
