Sister Kathy grew up in the Hamilton neighborhood of Baltimore City and attended St. Dominic School. After graduating from Catholic High, she attended St. Joseph's College in Emmitsburg, Maryland and then received her Master's in education from Loyola University. Following her vocation, she has been a teacher or a principal at several Catholic Schools, including at St. Charles School in Baltimore, St. Christine School in Ohio, Our Lady Queen of Peace School in Washington, D.C., St. Michael School in Baltimore, St. Mary School in Georgia, and St. Dominic School in Baltimore.
