We let our lights shine brightly before an audience of over 370 students, teachers, parents and staff to commemorate the enduring strength and brilliance that is the Catholic High of today. Our school continues to stand strong on the hill of the Raming Estate in the Edison Highway Community ~ 80 Years Strong: Lighting our Way Into the Future.

Over 80 years ago, the Sisters of Saint Francis of Philadelphia had a vision for young women and worked hard to raise the money to construct a unique building and offer educational programs rooted in Franciscan values that would light the way for the future of young women. *The Catholic High School of Baltimore* continues to be an extraordinary school — the only women's high school in the world sponsored by the Sisters of Philadelphia.
